- skills, the captain of the hermes is captain lin middleton his son is a helicopter pilot with another ship on the force, once the planes were airborne the captains sent all hand to action routine-enough drill,

- and we've also been warned that all beards will have shaved to off, in order to make gas masks fit properly, there was one break from flying today,
- to give the royal marines time to exercise, but with all the below-deck space full of men, machinery and ammunition,
- they have to use the flight deck, so for an hour each day even the precious flying time is given up to keep the marines fit to fight, saturday 10 april we went flying from hermes in a

- manoeuvring with two of the frigate escorts, their wakes cutting pale-blue paths through the deeper colours of the undisturbed ocean, they were battling with each other.






